PD must be purposeful

Onboarding

Does not meet competencies without thorough follow-up

A Site-Based-Plan for licensure must be comparable to a student attending an educator preparation program for certification at a college or university. All competencies must be met by the equivalence of college coursework.

They are earning the same license as those completing preparation programs

Please note experience, lesson plans, curriculum work, testing, and supervisor observations do not meet as completion of a competency. We ask how you acquired the skill not that is put into practice. Teacher Professional Development such as Ed2go, IRIS, simpleK12, NHAHPERD, NHMEA, Department of Education Workshops, etc. are meant to supplement those already licensed; not to supplant the learning to be completed by the equivalent of college coursework. One-Two hour Webinars are not equal to that of a college course.

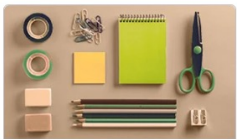

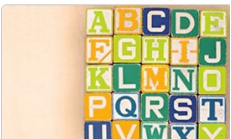
